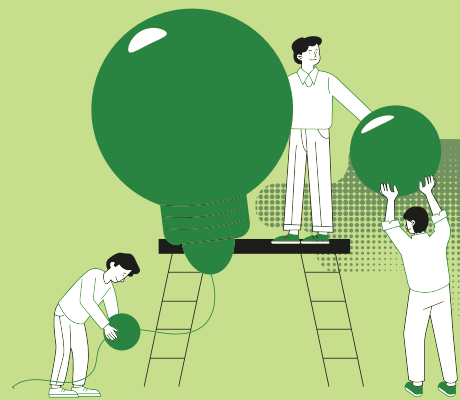

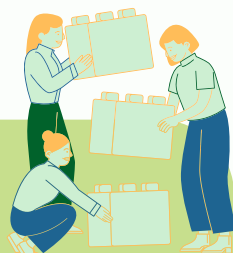
### Why webinars?
